Ratio of Farmers vs Artist/Crafters

- 50% Farmers, 50% Artist/Crafters

Market Day & Time

Saturday Mornings 8:30am – 12:00pm

Fees

- The market will start on June 27th and go to September 26th, 2026. A 50% deposit is required on or before June 1st if you are not taking advantage of the early bird special, then the balance is due on or before June 27th.

Please Note:

- Change Of Address For Telephone Number: vendors are responsible for ensuring that the Market Manager, Shari has a record of their current address and telephone numbers.
- The market does not provide water, electricity or tents to vendors. Generator use will be considered, and permission granted on a case by case basis.
- Sharing of booth space between two vendors is permitted providing all vendors are listed on the application forms and all conform to the Central Hastings Community Market criteria.
- Self contained kitchens in motorized trailers are allowed. All tents and other items including display stands, tables and chairs must be erected within 30 minutes of the market opening and must be removed within an hour after the market has closed.
- Vendors are **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** to carry personal liability insurance. If you do not have insurance go to <https://duuo.ca> they have the best rates for vendor insurance. As vendors \$33 for the season is not outrages. This was the average last year vendors paid.

Criteria:

The criteria required for participation in the farmers market are only Ontario grown produce and Ontario hand-made items (i.e. art, craft, jam and baking) will be allowed for sale and this will be closely monitored. No flea market items, no item must manufactured from a pattern, items must be made in Ontario by hand.

Farmers and Processors are defined as:

Farmers: (producers) are persons who grow produce (vegetables, fruits and nuts) herbs, flowers or nursery crops from seed or plants, and care for nurtured, cultivated and harvest the crops offered for sale at a farmers' market. Beekeepers, egg farmers, poultry growers, and fish growers are considered in this category.

Processors: are persons offering fresh food products that have added value to their product through some sort of "hands-on" processing (examples: smoked meats, baked goods, handmade candies etc).

Competition

More vendors that take part in the market is healthy. Some vendors prices maybe higher than others, but each vendor has right to their prices and the Chamber ask that all vendors respect other vendors. The Chamber's goal is to make sure we provide a healthy, happy environment for all to enjoy.
